With their changing brains and hormones, sometimes finding ways to integrate play with pre-teens and teens can at times just feel completely "awkward". Do we talk? Do we play? Do I ask questions? What do I do? With the help of neuroscience, interpersonal neurobiology, developmental theory and principles from Synergetic Play Therapy, this 6 hour workshop will shed light on how to navigate the therapy landscape with our clients who are no longer children, but also not quite yet adults!

Workshop Objectives

- Understand how to bring the Synergetic Play Therapy concept of "The Set Up/The Offering" into your work with pre-teens and teens
- Learn the neuroscience behind pre-teen and teen brain development
- Understand how to identify what is most important to a pre-teen and teen and how to use this information to enhance and engage your client
- Learn the importance of assessing a pre-teen and teens emotional age versus their chronological age
- Learn the most important goal when applying play therapy to your work with pre-teens and teens
- Understand why not having a script to follow is essential when working with this population
