**Workshop Objectives:**

- Identify four basic principles of intrapsychic and systemic theory that can build a foundation for the integration of play and family therapy.
- Identify family situations where bringing adults and children into the therapy space together would be helpful or counter-indicated at the present time.
- Learn three techniques for working therapeutically with the whole family together.
- Examine our own family themes in order to enhance our work with families
- Gain familiarity of children's grieving process at different stages of development.
- Explore trauma theory as it applies to working with young children
- Become more comfortable and skilled with the option of using both play and talk with families in the therapy room.
