This workshop is designed as a more in depth day for people working in a practitioner and/or therapeutic role with transgender and gender diverse children and adolescents. It uses up to date guidelines and standards of care and discusses concerns and complexities that practitioners may face.

The therapeutic framework for this training includes utilising Trauma Informed Principles, The Three Phased Approach, Internal Family Systems and a Child Development Model.

Workshop Objectives

- To gain an understanding of terminology and concepts related to gender diversity and ‘gender incongruence’, including the ‘pathological’ model and the ‘non-pathological’ model.
- To explore how to support children, adolescents, and their families, in social and medical transition, when and why these avenues might be appropriate, and what they may entail
- To gain understanding and knowledge in assessing and working with co-existing conditions like childhood trauma, sexual assault, mental health challenges and the autism spectrum
